## ABOUT THE GAME FILE . . .

Most die-hard Tecmo Super Bowl players have ideas about changes they would make to the game to make it better. Here are the hacks and edits that I believe make for the best game. To create the player ratings, I extracted this year's Madden ratings and fed them into a spreadsheet of my own formulas that then spits out Tecmo-compatible ratings. You might also notice that I'm actually using the "Running Power" attribute as an active category for offensive players instead of just assigning every player a 69 rating, as in the original game (which was, in my opinion, simply an oversight by the creators . . . or maybe just an easy way to finish the game and get it to market faster). I also changed its name to "Acceleration" to more accurately reflect its function. Here's an index of the hacks used to create this game, in no particular order, with authors in parenthesis:

- helmets, field colors (keithisgood)
- COM looks for open receivers (jstout)
- COM Ultra Logic to play better defense (jstout)
- moving & dynamic grapples (bruddog)
- MAN vs. MAN popcorning (jstout)
- sort receiving leaders by yards (jstout)
- more accurate attribute labels, like "Acceleration" (Tecmonster)
- kicking arrow speed & range to make FG's easier (Tecmonster)
- COM minimum kickoff distance (bruddog)
- increase kickoff ball speed (maynard, bodom)
- increase shotgun snap speed (jstout)
- tougher to block FG's by adding personal protectors (Tecmonster)
- increase QB fumble rate (jstout)
- decrease diving animation time slightly (xplozv)
- decrease handoff animation time (xplozv)
- COM "juice" edited (by Tecmonster)
- PA affects "catchability/interceptability" of the pass (jstout)
- set kick returner farther back (bodom)
- Ball Control ratios edited so BC means more (by Tecmonster)
- static schedules from week to week (bruddog)
- Quickness changed to Coverage (jstout)
- kick returners use their actual attributes (konforce, jstout)
- stats screen at halftime (xplozv)
- corrected playoff bracket (pambazos)
- MAN-controlled QB rollouts on the rollout plays (Tecmonster)
- LB's moved farther back from line of scrimmage (Tecmonster)
- Run & Shoot QB's almost never scramble (Tecmonster)
- "heavy pass" teams don't pass quite as much (Tecmonster)
- PLAYBOOKS (I have drastically changed and re-organized the playbooks to make them more useful, logical, balanced, and modern), including: (a) new plays, like the Shotgun Shovel, Shotgun Zone Read RB R, Shotgun Zone Read QB L (with QB HP boost), Shotgun RB Draw, Shotgun Zone Read Red Sea (pass), Shotgun Zone Read X Fly (pass), Shotgun Zone Read RB Flat (pass), Pro Set Quick Pitch L, Pro Set Quick Pitch R, Pro Set Zone Pitch R, 1back Ofttackle R, 1back Pitch R, 1back Pitch L, Run and Shoot Fire (pass), Shotgun XZ Cross, 1back Flare C, Pro Z Deep Post; (b) improved blocking schemes for many run plays; (c) some receiving routes for existing plays improved; (d) some receiving routes added, like for Oneback Flare A;
- COM avoids sacks much better + faster COM rollouts (Tecmonster)
- shorter onside kicks (xplozv)
- COM RB reacts to the defense sooner after handoff (Tecmonster)
- smarter OL pass blocking (xplozv)
- receiver jump/dive based on REC rating (xplozv)
- defender jump/dive based on COV rating (xplozv)
- team rosters, jersey #'s, faces (qbvikings, Tecmonster)

## TEAM OUTLOOK SUMMARY

These grades don't necessarily reflect the outlook of the actual NFL football teams, but rather their overall talent level in Tecmo Super Bowl. For instance, a major reason that the Broncos are great is because Peyton Manning might be the best decision-maker in the NFL, but that skill is moot in this video game because either a human player is making those decisions for him at QB, or a computer is, and the computer's decisions don't change based on the QB. Other players, like Jadeveon Clowney who are crazy fast at a combine, won't have crazy fast attributes because he's not expected to be "fast to the ball," at least early in his career (low Play Recognition & Pursuit ratings in Madden).

## WHAT DOES EACH TEAM'S "SALARY CAP" MEAN?

The **SALARY CAP** section at the top right of each team profile is what the Reno Tecmo League uses for its fantasy draft, and it's derived from the combined talent level (total # of attribute points) of the team's offensive line and defense. The worse a team's "OL+Defense" is, the higher that team's salary cap will be, which is then used to buy that team's starting offensive skill players -- one QB, one RB, two WR's, one TE, and one FLEX player, which can be either a RB or a WR. The cost of each player = the total # of attribute points, converted to a dollar amount by dividing by 100. So, for example, a player with 287 attribute points, costs \$2.87 million against the salary cap. The Reno Tecmo League starts the draft with each owner drafting his base team, and then each ensuing round is used to fill out the rest of his roster (the aforementioned starting offensive skill players). TSBToolSupreme is used to edit rosters but, if you do this, the game might experience a glitch after editing, and that glitch is rooted in the moving grapples hack. Check the thread where you downloaded this game to get the fix.

## BUFFALO BILLS

**ANALYSIS:** Dual threat QB Tyrod Taylor leads a multi-pronged offense that boasts talent everywhere you look. RB's McCoy and Brown form a potent 1-2 punch. One of the best defenses in the league starts with an epicly stout defensive line, where all 3 starters are stars. LB Bradham is solid in the middle.

**SUMMARY:** Super Bowl Contender (B) with a run-based, multi-set offense.

### MIAMI DOLPHINS

**ANALYSIS:** The Dolphins lack any power in their run game, but they lean on QB Ryan Tannehill to create plays with both his arm and his legs, and he's capable of doing just that. Studs Cameron Wake and Ndamukong Suh anchor a great defensive line, while up front MLB Koa Misi and FS Reshad Jones to make plays.

**SUMMARY:** Playoff Contender (C) with a pass-based, multi-set offense.

## AFC NORTH

**CINCINNATI BENGALS**

**ANALYSIS:** With Andy Dalton still supplying just OK production out of the QB position, this offense will hitch its wagon to 2nd-year phenom Jeremy Hill, a strong balance of speed and power, and a road-grading o-line. Geno Atkins is an explosive disruptor on the d-line, and MLB Burfict is as solid as a rock.

**SUMMARY:** Playoff Contender (C) with a run-based, 1back offense.

**CLEVELAND BROWNS**

**ANALYSIS:** Johnny Football returns with a lot to prove after last year's let-downs. He's got talent, and his o-line is elite, but the skill positions are weak. The strength of the defense is the back 7, and MLB Karlos Dansby dominates with quickness and power. CB Joe Haden is an unshakeable ball hawk.

**SUMMARY:** Playoff Contender (C) with a run-based, 2back offense.

**BALTIMORE RAVENS**

**SUMMARY:** Super Bowl Contender (B) with a balanced, 2back offense.

**PITTSBURGH STEELERS**

**ANALYSIS:** The emergence of RB Le'veon Bell as a superstar has turned the Steelers into one of the most explosive offenses in the league and, with Big Ben firing bullets to elite receivers like Brown and Bryant, points will come in bunches. LB Timmons is one of the most underrated run-stoppers in the NFL.

**SUMMARY:** Playoff Contender (C) with a balanced, 1back offense.

## INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

**ANALYSIS:** QB Andrew Luck has an elite skill set and will only get better with age and experience, and now he has a legitimate run game in RB Frank Gore to help keep defenses off-balance. WR T.Y. Hilton's star is on the rise. The Colts' Achilles heel is defense, but DB Vontae Davis is makes life hell for enemy QB's.
